

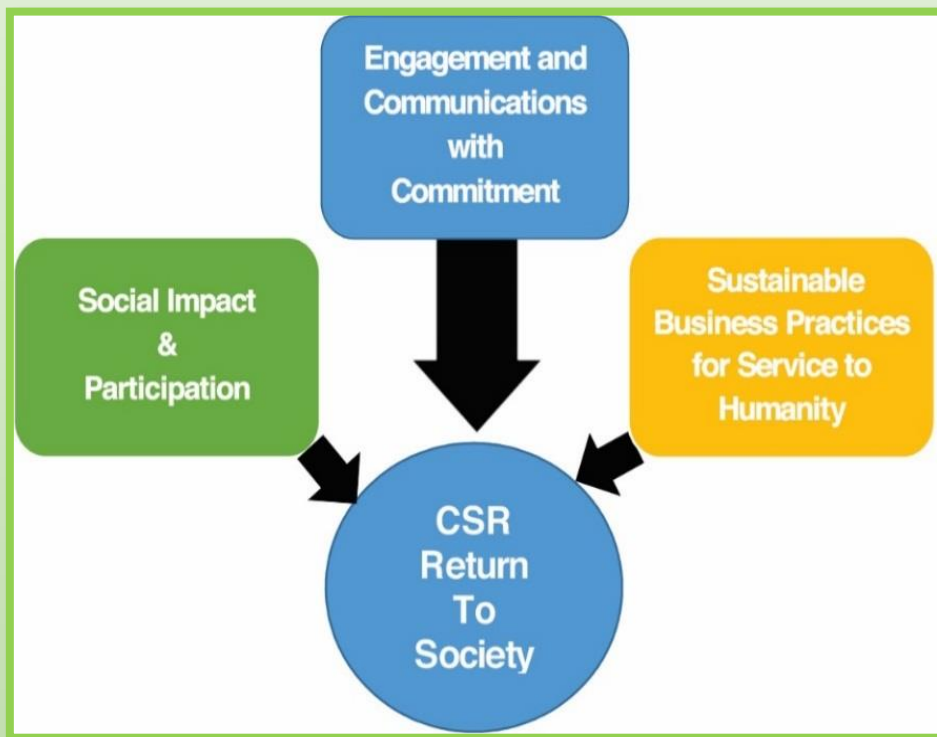

Total no of women enrolled with us was 120, when we surveyed and registered for the Adult Literacy program.

Yoga classes are being taken in two batch from afternoon 2.30pm to 4.30pm on every Tuesday & Saturday (one a week).

## Achievements

Children spent their time aimlessly playing marbles, cards and climbed trees in Jogeshawari & Aarey, vanicha pada. They were afraid of coming to Mera Sapna sessions with proper intervention of our teachers they have started coming to class on regular basis and are learning to respect time. They have started having fixed time for playing, our sessions and their homework.

We use community centre to conduct our classes. Being a common space it was used by individuals from the village to consume drugs and ganjas in evening time. Our teachers along with some students visited individuals homes and worked hard to make them understand the importance of education and negative effect of the existing behaviour. It took us time but we are seeing positive results as the activities have reduced and hope for it to complete stop in the near future.



## English



A student has fear to communicate in the English. We are starting with Basic English classes. Eg. Small word making, myself etc. This will give courage to students to speak in English. Spoken English class is conducted twice a week.

## Art & Craft

Art teaches children to be more aware of themselves and others. Creating art teaches focus and perseverance. Art helps children express their emotions in a positive way. From our classes we got to know that some students are very good in drawing. We will be keeping track on those students and will give them necessary support. .



## Science



We strongly believe Science is one of the Important channel of knowledge generates solutions for everyday life and helps us to answer the great mysteries of the universe Science properties of matter In which we taught them about anything which occupies space and have mass is matter, further we discussed three types of matter, solid, liquid, and gas and their properties, Heating and cooling a substance may change it from one state to another, when a material changes state, its smallest units, called molecules, behave differently



## Geography

One of the important topics Geography introduced in Mera Sapna officially from December 2021, as geography helps to explore and understand space and place – recognizing the great differences in cultures, political systems, economies, landscapes, and environments across the world, and exploring the links between them, same time it helps to understand the physical world, such as land, air, water, and ecology. Dancing and singing is also a great way for children to use their time and develop skills when they are not in school. Students can't always communicate their feelings through words, so it's useful for them to have a healthy outlet for their emotions. We have some students who are good singers and dancers too and with the help of our classes we are encouraging their passion for dancing & singing.



## 8. HEALTH

### 8.1 Cancer Screening Camp for Fishermen Family held at Macchimar Nagar-Colaba, on 12th April, 2022 in association with Cancer Patients Aid Association (CPAA)

Cancer Patients Aid Association (CPAA) is a registered, charitable organization working towards Total Management of Cancer Patients-Awareness to Rehabilitation, since the last 53 years. This camp proved to be very helpful for them as they would have not taken initiative to go for the checkup. In this camp we screened 86 females.

All ladies were taught self-breast examination by their gynecologist and were given pamphlets of the same to practice once in the month regularly.

Tobacco habituates were counselled and given tips to quit tobacco.

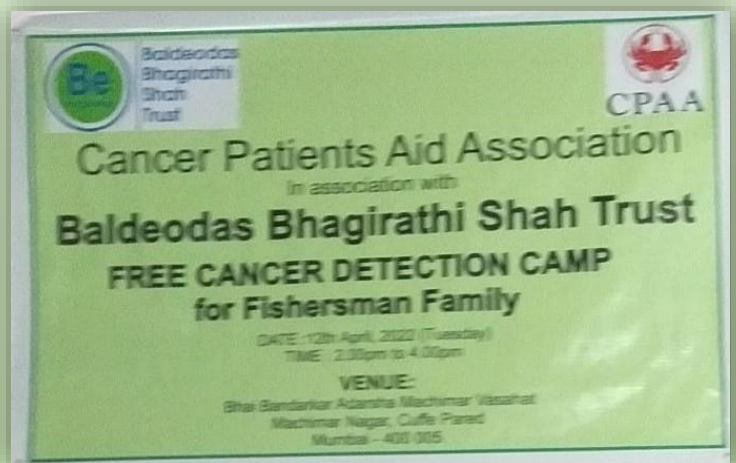

The First batch of Udaan students passed out on 30th August 2021 and it was a proud moment for all of us including our teachers to see how much the kids had transformed during their 3 month course with us during which they learned Computer, English, Life skills, Science and Maths in an interactive, participative and activity based pedagogy. Most children had never touched a computer before and they gave PowerPoint presentations!

Similarly they could not express themselves in English earlier but now they shared their experience in English !

The day also saw the inauguration of the second batch and we hope these parindes too will benefit immensely and fly high.

The Chief guest of the event was Mr. Vandan Shah, MD of Sipra Engineers Pvt Ltd. and Managing Trustee of M/s B B Shah Trust. Mr Vandan and his wife Ms. Ekta Shah have been very supportive of all DBM projects through their trust and in fact the very first batch of Udaan too was supported by them. Mr. Vandan motivated the children with the story of his father and the industry he set up. The children were very fascinated to hear about the precision parts that they make and were thrilled when Mr. Vandana invited them to his factory for a visit.

The passing out children received Certificates along with a goodie bag sponsored by Prof. RSS Mani and a very motivating book by the author Shri Hariharan Iyer. A big thanks to them and to Mr. Vandan Shah for his presence.

They are not noticed and hunger is a big issue during lockdown coupled with cyclone.

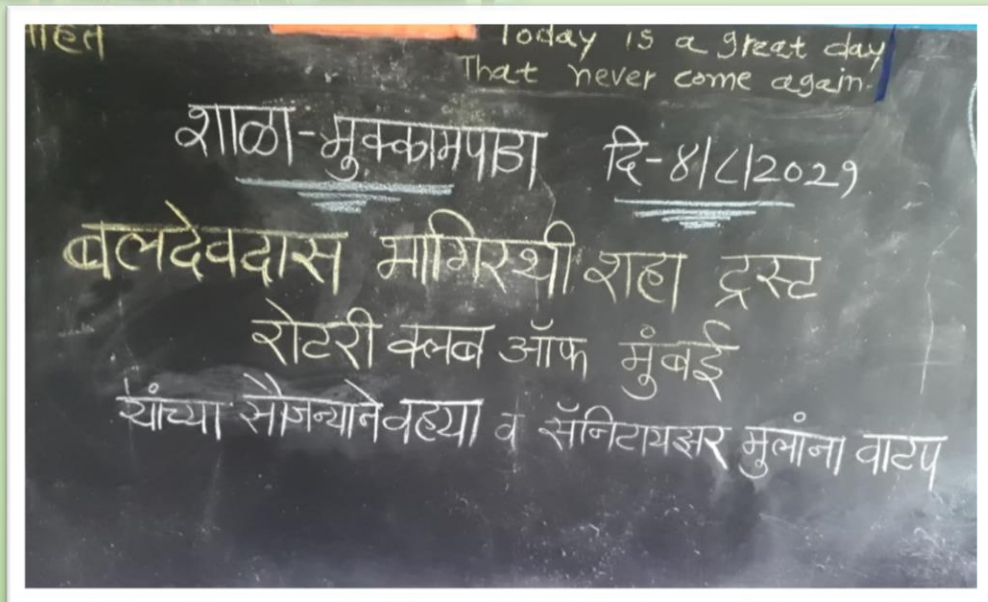
We identified 120 such families who needed urgent attention in the two villages of Nimbargi & Mandrup in Solapur.

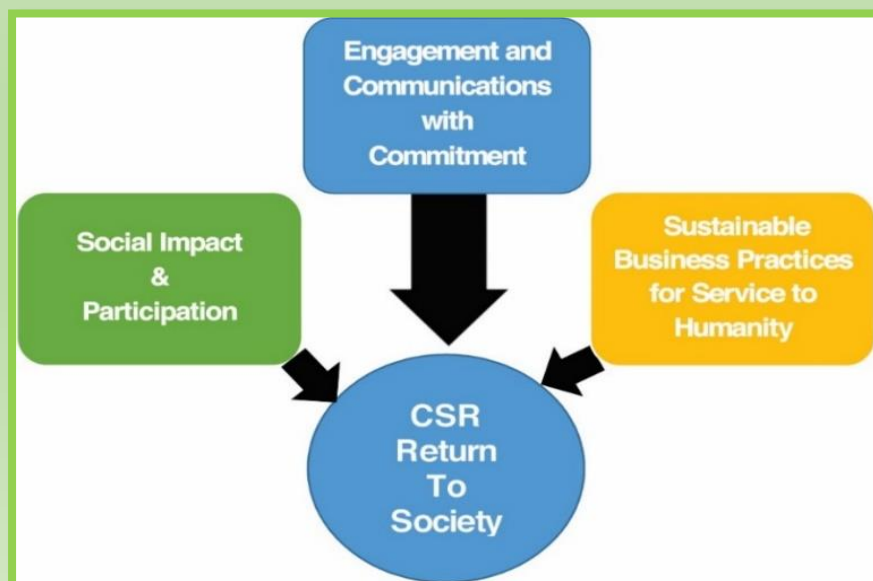
### Objective

  - V. Hospitals

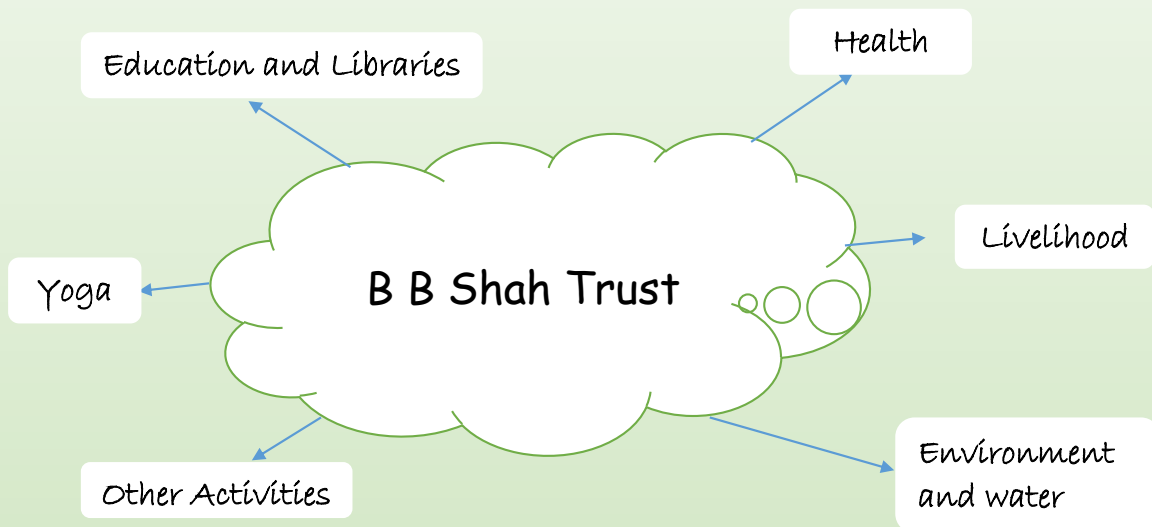
Whether existing, new or that may come into being hereafter.

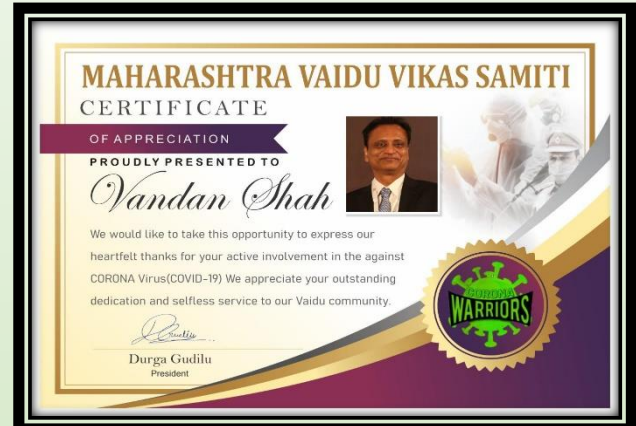
